

More than a museum housing artifacts, the Chennault Museum leads several veterans' initiatives, and presents numerous annual events to honor active-duty military and veterans. This gives our civilian community a chance to connect with those who serve. The museum works with veteran-oriented organizations in the community, throughout the U.S., and abroad.


- Veteran Oral Histories: In partnership with the Library of Congress, we collect and preserve veterans' stories, making them accessible to families and future generations
- Veteran Closet: This community-driven initiative provides gently used clothing and essential items to local veterans, helping them transition to civilian life with dignity
- Gen. Claire Chennault Chapter 51 of
 Disabled American Veterans (DAV): Offers
 advocacy and free transportation to the VA
 Medical Center, ensuring veterans receive
 the benefits and care they deserve
- Expanded PTSD Support: Our free, bimonthly PTSD support groups, led by a Vietnam veteran with a PhD in psychology, now include first responders and spouses of service members, offering therapy sessions tailored to their unique needs
